Registration and Abstract Submission

To submit an abstract of your contribution, please follow the instructions on the online submission form and fill in the appropriate fields. The length of the abstract is limited to one page in A-4 size format. Abstract template and example can be obtained from http://ieic5.org/wp-content/uploads/2017/02/abstract_format.docx. This abstract will be used by the session organizers to select speakers. Those not selected for oral presentation will be offered the opportunity to present a poster.

To make presentation, registration and abstract submission should be completed **not later than 31 May 2017**.
